Welcome to Paladar! Our wine list has more than 60 wines sourced exclusively from the length and breadth of Latin America.

Most of the wines are from Argentina and Chile, but we have also uncovered some gems from countries not best known for wine production: Mexico, for example, is home to the oldest winery in the Americas, whilst Peru was producing high quality wines by the early 1600s.

We also showcase some great wines from Brazil and Uruguay and less well-known regions of Argentina - Salta, Patagonia and San Juan - as well as less familiar Chilean valleys, such as Huasco, Itata and Elqui.

The list also encompasses a wide range of different wine styles and grape varieties - some of which you may not be very familiar with, including Petit/Gros Manseng, Cesar Noir, Grüner Veltliner, Friulano, Marselan and Touriga Nacional.

We particularly encourage you to try the region's "Criolla" varieties. These are the offspring of the original grape varieties that the Spanish Conquistadors took to Latin America in the 16th Century. With fascinating grape names like Criolla Grande, Quebranta, Torrontés and Moscatel Rosado, these wines are best served slightly chilled and are ideal for summer drinking - we have highlighted these (and the "parent" varieties) as "Criollas" on the list.
