

WINE LIST: Summer 2025

Welcome to Paladar! Our wine list has more than 70 wines sourced exclusively from the length and breadth of Latin America.

Most of the wines are from Argentina, Chile and Uruguay, but we have also uncovered gems from countries not best known for wine production, like Mexico and Peru... and we have just added two excellent wines from Ecuador - a real surprise!

We also showcase some great wines from Brazil and less well-known regions of Argentina - Salta, Patagonia, La Rioja and San Juan - as well as less familiar Chilean valleys, such as Huasco, Itata and Elqui.

The list encompasses a wide range of different wine styles and grape varieties - some of which you may not be very familiar with, including César Noir, Grüner Veltliner, Petit/Gros Manseng, Friulano, Marselan and Arinarnoa.

We particularly encourage you to try the region's "Criolla" varieties. These are the offspring of the original grape varieties that the Spanish Conquistadors took across the Atlantic in the 16th Century. Born in South America with fascinating grape names like Quebranta, Torrontés Criolla Grande and Moscatel Rosado, the wines are best served slightly chilled. We have highlighted these, and their "parent" varieties.

Bargain hunters need look no further than the first page (the "Bin Ends") where we are discounting those wines being de-listed.

Our "By the Glass" selection includes a number of more offbeat options - including some Criollas and a lovely white Malbec. As far as possible, we are keeping wines by the glass at less than £10 each (and hope you can enjoy more than one!)

This year we are working towards a "Lower and Lighter" theme: Lower in price and in alcohol and Lighter in style and in bottle weight. For some time now, we have been selecting wines that are not in unnecessarily heavy bottles - being firm believers in the motto "its what's in the bottle that counts"! As from this list, we are now highlighted all wines of 12%ABV and less as "Lower Alcohol".

Be bold and adventurous... We encourage you to discover the diversity of Latin American wines!

Don Guerino, Sinais Itálico Riesling | Rio Grande do Sul, Brazil | 13.2% ABV 2023 61 Gorgeous zingy dry white wine, with restrained melon, peach and citrus flavours, and very different from its German namesake. 2017 58 Ventisquero, Grey Glacier Sauvignon Blanc | Loncomilla Vineyard, Huasco Valley, Atacama, Chile | 12,5% ABV Fresh and round on the palate, citrus aromas with a good acidity and great minerality. This is a tremendous wine from a desert-like region in northern Chile with stony-sandy soil and virtually no rainfall. Bodega Garzón, Reserva Albariño | Maldonado, Uruguay | 12.5% ABV 2024 62 With a cool, moist Atlantic climate Uruguay is producing some excellent Albariños. The Garzon winery is crisp, with ripe aromas of white peach and citrus fruits, good structure, and a mouth-watering finish. Errazuriz, Aconcagua Costa Chardonnay | Aconcagua Valley, Chile | 13.5% ABV 2022 61 An elegant Chardonnay displaying tropical fruit, honey and floral notes on the nose. This is a beautifully crafted and well balanced wine from a Pacific coast vineyard offering a bright mineral edge and juicy mouth feel. Zuccardi, Poligonos Verdejo | Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina | 13% ABV 2020 86 This wonderfully crisp, honest wine has a rich and deep expression of the San Pablo vineyard. Beautifully dovetailed tropical fruit with crisp acidity and terrific chalky minerality. Guaspari, Vale da Pedra, Branco Sauv Blanc/Chardonnay/Viognier | Sao Paulo State, Brazil | 14% ABV 2021 89 This unusual but elegant white blend offers citrus notes, grassiness and hints of unripe coffee. Stonefruit and other tropical flavours dominate on a fresh, dry palate with a mineral note and a long finish. Gusapari is a relatively new winery, set up on a former coffee plantation and has achieved almost cult status. 2021 90 Dos Hemisferios, Enigma Chardonnay | San Miguel del Morro, Guayas, Ecuador | 12% ABV The enigma is how a low-altitude vineyard almost on the equator can produce wine as good as this! The very best grapes are selected and vinified from both vintages in the year. 30% of the wine is then aged in French oak before final blending. The nose of tropical fruits and honey leads into an elegant, complex palate.

Miolo, Alísios 2023 41 Tempranillo/Touriga Nacional | Seival Estate, Campanha, Brazil | 13% ABV A fresh, easy drinking, medium-bodied red from vineyards in the very south of Brazil close to the Uruguayan border. Ripe berry flavours, with soft tannins and a rich mouthfeel. 46 Mauricio Lorca, Recoleta Criolla Grande | Mendoza, Argentina | 13.5% ABV 2023 Criolla Variety A natural cross between Criolla Chica (aka Listán Prieto) and Muscat of Alexandria, Criolla Grande makes a very light and refreshing red wine that could almost be a full-bodied rosé. We serve it chilled - perfect for spring/summer dining and a perfect match with many of our dishes. 2022 47 La Mascara Malbec | Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina | 13.5% ABV Focusing on sustainability, this Malbec is made in Argentina but bottled in lightweight bottles in London, thus ensuring a lower carbon footprint. A well-priced Malbec showing that good quality doesn't have to cost the earth! Finca Las Nubes Cabernet Sauvignon/Malbec | Calchaguí Valleys, Salta, Argentina | 14% ABV 2023 46 Medium-bodied intense red from high altitude vineyards at over 1,700 metres above sea level offering attractive aromas of ripe plums and blackberries with a persistant finish. 2022 La Ronciere, Cantoalba Pinot Noir | Fundo Idahue, Licantén, Chile | 13% ABV 44 This attractive bright Pinot Noir offers aromas of red and black fruit with hints of violet and coconut. Juicy tannins and a lovely freshness make this wine great value for money. Bodegones del Sur, Vineyard Select Marselan | Juanicó, Canelones, Uruguay | 13% ABV 2021 50 This little known grape variety was created in France in 1961 by artifically crossing Cab Sauv with Grenache. Red berries on the nose leads to a velvety palate and a long finish. 2023 48 Viñas Queirolo, Intipalka Syrah | Ica Valley, Peru | 14% ABV A well-structured wine from 25-year old vines, with light spices, dark berries and a hint of floral notes. 2020 54 Casa Silva, Romano César Noir | Colchagua Valley, Chile | 13.5% ABV This obscure grape variety hails from Burgundy, where it is used as a blending variety with Pinot Noir. Intense ruby red colour. Red fruits with hints of strawberry, cherry and earthy aromas on the nose. The palate offers a good structure with unctuous tannins and a good balance between structure and acidity. 2023 56 Verum, Cool Climate Malbec | Upper Rio Negro Valley, Patagonia, Argentina | 13.5% ABV A very elegant expression of Malbec - softer and more nuanced than that from Mendoza and Salta. This is a lovely wine showing good tannin ripeness accompanied by freshness and persistence.

With a little age on it this is drinking really well now! Viña Salort Tannat | Canelones, Uruguay | 13.5% ABV 2022 55 This grape variety originates in Southwest France, but has found a second home in Uruguay where it thrives. The tannins have been rounded out by oak ageing leaving it smooth and elegant on the palate with a lovely freshness. Domingo Molina Malbec | Calchaquí Valleys, Salta, Argentina | 14% ABV 2019 60 A rich and intense ruby red wine with notes of plum, dark cherries, vanilla and mocha on the nose. Elegantly structured with a long smooth finish, this is a great example of high altitude wines from Salta. 59 Maturana Wines, Negra San Francisco | Loncomilla Valley, Maule, Chile | 13% ABV **Criolla Parent Variety** 2022 This refreshing 'Negra' is made from the rare red San Francisco grape variety (aka Negramoll and Mollar). This wine boasts an intense nose of cherries, with appealing spice undertones. The palate is fresh. with plenty of red fruit flavours and soft tannins. We serve this wine slightly chilled. 62 Viña Arboleda 2021/22 Carménère | Aconcagua Valley, Chile | 13.5% ABV This wine has a dense and dark cherry-red colour; It opens elegantly to reveal an elegant palate with soft, silky tannins and a long, pleasant finish: a great example of quality Carménère. Arboldeda is a personal project from Eduardo Chadwick, undoubtedly one of Chile's premier winemakers. Bresesti, Pequeñas Colecciones Arinarnoa | Las Violetas, Canelones, Uruguay | 12.5% ABV 2021 59 Pepper and spice and all things nice... this rich, full-bodied red is a real gem made from an unusual grape variety created by artificially crossing Cabernet Sauvignon with Tannat. We serve it slightly chilled. Rogue Vine, Grand Itata, Tinto Cinsault/País | Itata, Chile | 13% ABV 2021 65 A juicy and expressive light red made from grapes from old bush vines grown on granitic soils just 16 kilometers from the Pacific coast. We serve this wine slightly chilled. Colomé, Lote Especial 2021 68 Bonarda | Calchaguí Valleys, Salta, Argentina | 14% ABV With fruit from the high altitude vinevards at Finca La Brava, this Bonarda shows aromas of black and red fruits. Concentrated and complex on the palate with round tannins and a lovely freshness on the finish. 2018 69 Viña Maguis, Lien Cabernet Franc/Carménère/Cabernet Sauvignon | Colchagua Valley, Chile | 14.5% ABV Aromas of licorice, cumin and bay leaf are appealing on the nose of this superb Cabernet Franc-led blend.
